The NBTA brings together people, passion and resources to address the barriers faced by those from a black, Asian, mixed race or minority ethnic genetic heritage needing a whole organ transplant, stem cell transplant or blood transfusion.

**The NBTA** is an alliance of organisations who are working to achieve better experiences and outcomes for black, Asian, mixed race and minority ethnic (BAME) people who need matching organ or stem cell transplants and blood donations.

The Alliance is made up of organisations working specifically with BAME communities and representatives from national bodies, the NHS and the voluntary sector.

## ***NBTA wants to make change happen!***

Evidence suggests that black, Asian, mixed race and minority ethnic people needing an organ, stem cells or well matched blood donations are at higher risk of waiting longer and this is often accompanied by poorer experiences.

Our Alliance is working to eliminate delays and improve experiences by increasing donations. At the same time we are working to ensure all black, Asian, mixed race and minority ethnic people needing an organ transplant, stem cells or blood donation are treated with dignity and respect.



## ***Become a member of NBTA.***

**Membership** of NBTA provides:

- Proactive input on national strategy on transplantation working at a strategic level with NHS Blood and Transplant and Department of Health and Social Care.
- Collaborative working with statutory and voluntary organisations to improve donation and transplantation for BAME communities
- Seek funds for bespoke projects to improve sustainability of BAME-led voluntary, religious and community sector organisations supporting stem cell and organ donation/transplantation, and blood donation/transfusion

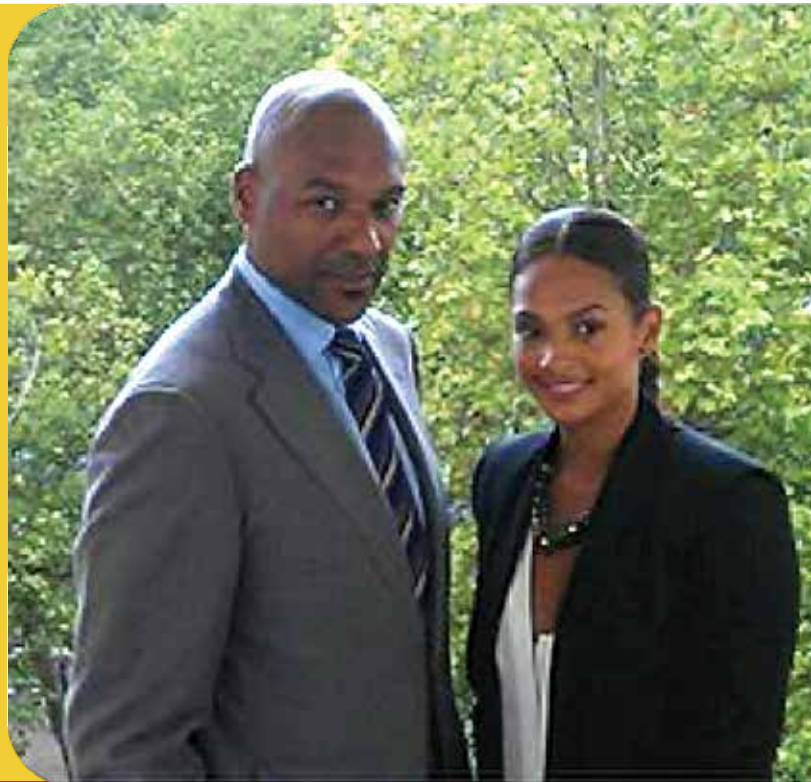
